Your research paper must be typed, have a cover page and consist of the following sections: Introduction, Procedure, Work Log, Results, Evaluation, and Appendix. Each section will be explained in the following paragraphs.

Introduction:

This section should introduce the project, what your expectations are, and what knowledge you expect to gain from the project.

Procedure:

This section should describe, in detail, the procedure you used in planning, designing, and building your project. Include reasons why you picked your design. You should describe the techniques used and how you constructed your project. Someone reading this section should be able to recreate your project from beginning to end with the information given.

Work Log:

A simple log of when you worked on your project and what you accomplished during those sessions. This should be done in a table format.

Results:

A short concise, factual summary of the test procedures and the results you obtained.

Evaluation:

Your evaluation should consist of the good points and the bad points of your project. Include ways that you could have changed your project to meet the expectations you set at the beginning. Include any new ideas or improvements you would have developed.

Appendix:

This section should include any drawings, supplies list, and budget report.
